Instructions

This award is designed to recognize those unique individuals who deserve special attention by virtue of their broad and significant contributions to the welfare of children and the field of school psychology in a number of areas (i.e., professional practice; research; state, regional and national leadership; training and supervision; community service, etc.).

The Distinguished Service Award will recognize those individuals who engage in supervision; research; program development and evaluation and other unique activities which may not include the full range of school psychological services.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Complete and sign the nominations statements. These statements should refer to specific examples of outstanding contributions to the lives of children and the field of school psychology (i.e., program development; supervision of staff; adherence to high professional standards; a proactive stance toward delivery of services; presentations at conferences; contributions to professional journals; organizational leadership; consultation skills; accessibility, and efforts to stay abreast of new developments in the field.
- 2) Up to five, one-page letters of support may be sent with the nomination statement. Each letter must be typed and signed by the author. All documentation should be submitted in the same envelope as the nomination statement.
- 3) The deadline for nominations is September 1, 2008. Send documentation to:

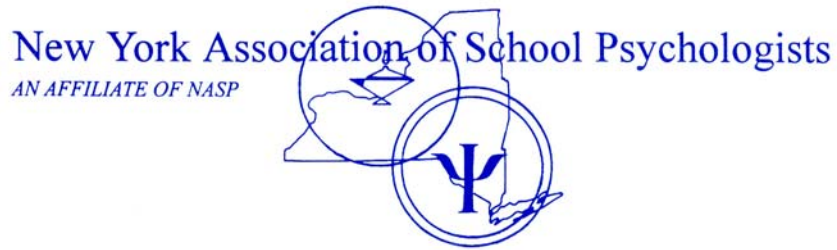
